Map ID #S03 Key Agreements As of April 03, 2017

- **A. Alignment:** This trail is intended to formalize the access/egress point at Snowcreek VIII as identified in the Snowcreek VIII Master Plan.
 - 1. Trailhead and Destination(s): Snowcreek VIII, the Sherwins Trailhead (Borrow Pit Staging Area), the stacked-loop system (see Summer Map ID #S08), the non-motorized "backbone" trail (see Summer Map ID #S07), and the Mammoth Rock Trail.
 - 2. Naming: Snowcreek Connector Trail
 - **3. Control Points/Narrative:** The private-property owner's future development plans will influence the exact location of this trail. Please see attached SHARP ID #S03 map.
 - 4. Map Reference: SHARP TTC: Map ID #S03, 03/15/17
- B. Design Specifications:
 - **1. Trail Type:** Type 2 (Preferred Hike)
 - 2. Users: Non-motorized
 - 3. Width: Tread narrow less than 36"
 - **4. Grade:** Grades may occasionally be steeper than 10%, including stair steps.
 - 5. Surface: Native materials
 - **6. Features:** None
 - 7. User Experience/Aesthetics: This trail is intended to formalize a year-round access/egress point between the stacked-loop trail system and Snowcreek VIII.
 - 8. Trail Amenities: Trail amenities and facilities will be limited to signage and the area will be served by public transit (see Summer Map ID #S28).
- C. Winter/Summer Interface: This alignment has intersections with the following SHARP projects: #S18, #S08, and #W09a. SHARP ID #W05a follows this exact alignment, as a result, summer signage will need to be placed so that they do not hinder or obstruct winter grooming.
- **D. Signage and Wayfinding Special Considerations:** As directed by the *Mammoth Lakes Trail System Wayfinding and Signage Standards Manual.*
