Map ID #S04 Key Agreements As of April 13, 2017

- **A. Alignment:** This project is intended to develop a multi-use staging area at Mill City, located at the Old Mammoth Road winter closure.
 - 1. Trailhead and Destination(s): Mammoth Rock Trail's western endpoint, Panorama Vista Trail/Panorama Dome Trail's eastern endpoints, and the Lakes Basin.
 - 2. Naming: Mill City Trailhead
 - 3. Control Points/Narrative: See attached SHARP ID #S04 map.
 - 4. Map Reference: SHARP TTC: Map ID #S04, 04/12/17
- B. Design Specifications:
 - 1. Facility Type: Staging Area/Trailhead.
 - **2. Users:** Non-motorized and Motorized (after April 16)
 - 3. Surface: Asphalt
 - **4. Trail Amenities:** Trail amenities and facilities will include signage, expanded parking, bathrooms, and a turnaround for public transit.
- **C. Winter/Summer Interface:** Overlaps with SHARP ID #W06, #S14, #W08 and #W07.
- **D. Signage and Wayfinding Special Considerations:** As directed by the *Mammoth Lakes Trail System Wayfinding and Signage Standards Manual.* Trailhead signage will be needed at this site with both winter and summer safety, recreation, and trail etiquette messages.

- B. Design Specifications:
 - 1. Facility Type: Multi-Use Staging Area
 - 2. Users: Non-motorized and Motorized (after April 17)
 - 3. Surface: Pavement and Snow
 - 4. User Experience/Aesthetics: This facility will provide an alternative to the Borrow Pit Staging Area (SHARP ID #W01) which will relieve pressure on the main parking/staging areas at the eastern end of the Sherwins and provide an alternative access/egress point to the Sherwins area for non-motorized users wishing total separation from OSV staging prior to April 17. It will also relieve pressure on the existing Lake Mary Road Winter Closure Staging Area.
 - Facility Amenities: Amenities will include signage, expanded parking, and bathrooms.
- **C. Winter/Summer Interface:** Overlaps SHARP ID #S14, #S04, #W08, and #W07.


