### Map ID #W03 Key Agreements As of July 21, 2017

- **A. Alignment:** This project is intended to establish an additional off-loading area for OSV users near the Sherwins Trailhead.
  - Trailhead and Destination(s): Sherwins Trailhead and Sherwin Creek Road.

- **B.** Design Specifications:
  - 1. Facility Type: OSV Off-Loading Area
  - **2. Users:** Motorized: OSV
  - 3. Surface: Asphalt
  - **4. User Experience/Aesthetics:** This facility is intended to enable divers to drop off or pick up both motorized users more efficiently. The proposed site's distance from the main staging area will naturally contribute to separation of use.
  - **5. Facility Amenities:** The OSV off-loading area will feature a turnaround large enough to accommodate a pickup truck with a trailer (but not limited to OSV use) and large parking spaces for vehicles with trailers.
- C. Winter/Summer Interface: Overlaps with SHARP ID #S01 and SHARP ID#W01. Trailhead signage will need to be placed so that they do not hinder or obstruct winter grooming or snow removal. Both summer and winter trailhead projects need to be developed in conjunction with the OSV staging area in order to ensure flow, ease, and efficiency of the user experiences for both the motorized and non-motorized users.
- **D. Signage and Wayfinding Special Considerations:** As directed by the *Mammoth Lakes Trail System Wayfinding and Signage Standards Manual.*



ORIGINAL SHARP CONCEPT	Additional off-loading area for OSV users near the Borrow Pit Staging Area.  Extend a spur from the Borrow Pit Staging Area along Sherwin Creek Road that ends in a turnaround that can accommodate a pickup truck with a trailer, but is not limited to or reserved strictly for OSV users. Facilities will be limited to signage; users will access additional facilities at the main Borrow Pit Staging Area (see Winter Map ID #01).		
ORIGINAL SHARP RATIONALE	Providing an additional off-loading area with a turnaround will help to relieve potential congestion at the formal borrow pit staging area, enabling drivers to drop off or pick up both motorized and non-motorized users more efficiently and with ease. The proposed site's distance from the main staging area will naturally contribute to separation of use.
