

# High Sierra Fall Century Ride is coming

The 17th Annual High Sierra Fall Century is Sept. 10, 2011. The 100-mile course takes cyclists along the east side of the High Sierra and into the quiet beauty of the Mono Basin with awesome views of Mono Lake and the White Mountains. The route offers 100 miles of riding with no stoplights and just one stop sign.

Those who don't want to ride the full 100 miles can take on shorter courses (options

of 30 and 45 miles will also be offered).

On course will be five feed stations and a catered lunch stop, along with three tech support vehicles to keep your bike running well. The ride includes a BBQ lunch back at Whitmore Ball Field with entertainment on hand. Entry cost for the 100 miles is \$60.

All proceeds from the High Sierra Fall Century will benefit the Sierra Cycling Foundation.
