BENEFIT/MEMORIAL AT THE DUB

On Saturday, September 10, a tragic traffic accident claimed the life of a Mammoth Lakes resident and severely injured 3 more locals.

While traveling west on Highway 80 outside Laramie, Wyo., a vehicle carrying Travis Mann, Ashley Hailey, Chris Ricci and William 'Billy' Krawisz was struck from behind by a tractor trailer, ultimately causing the vehicle to lose control and roll over twice. All passengers were ejected during the accident and Billy died on the scene. Travis, Chris and Ashley suffered extensive injuries and are currently receiving medical care.
