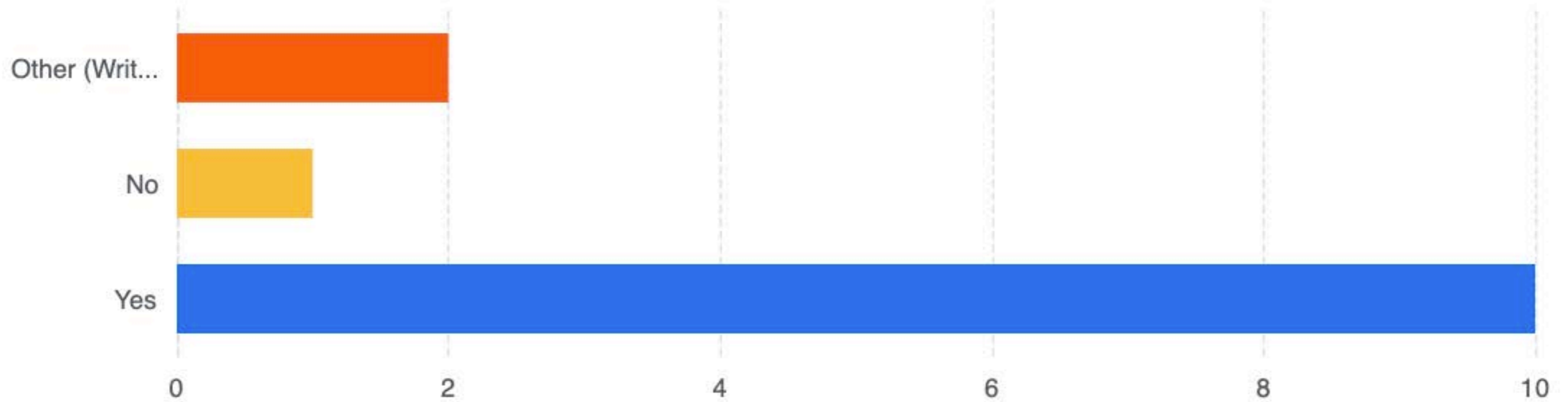


1. Does your project have a theory of change that includes local government? (Single choice) \*

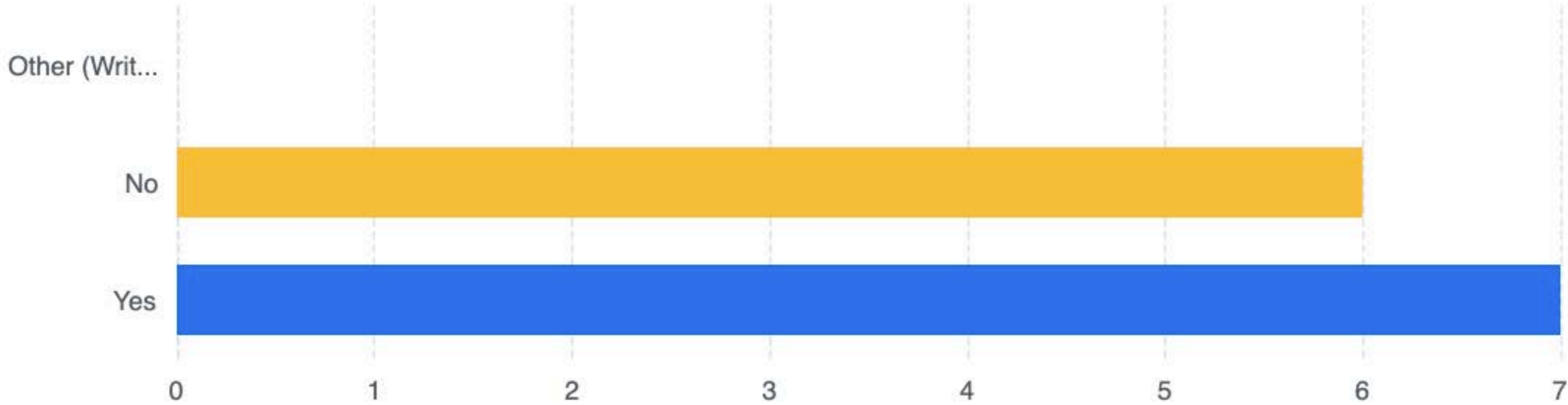

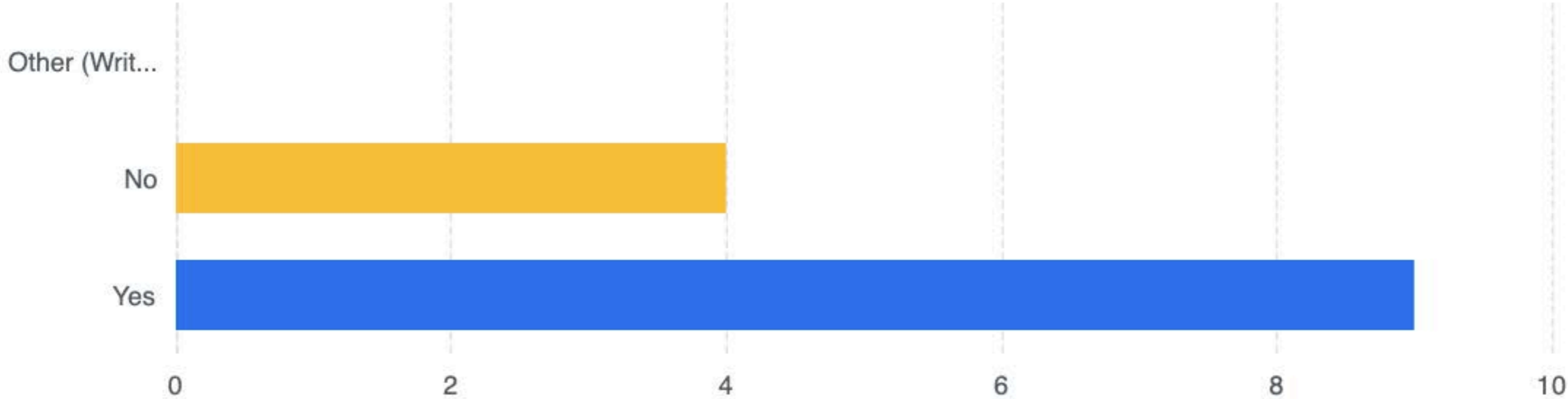

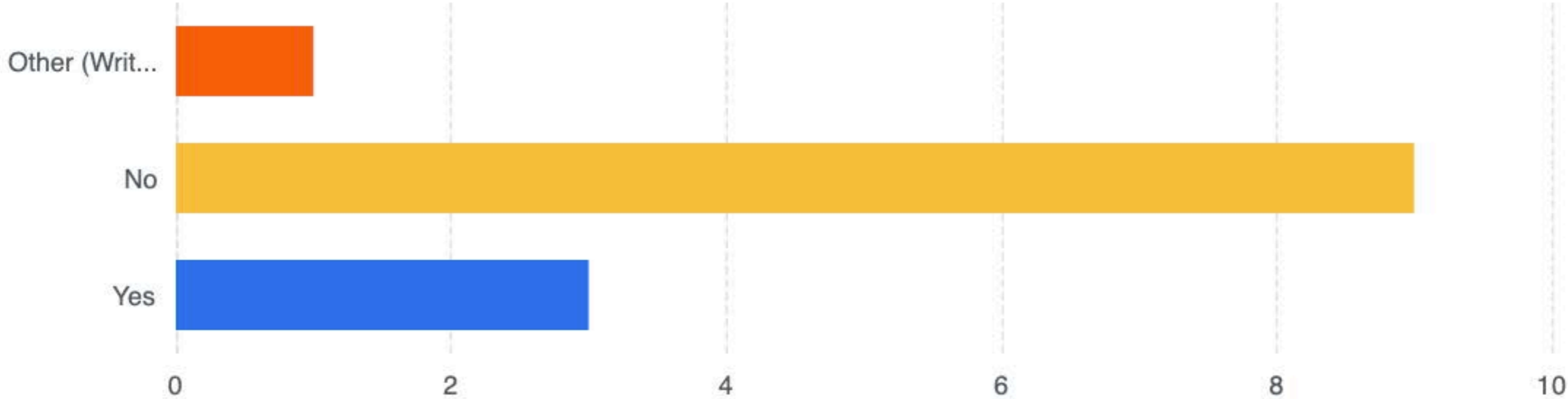

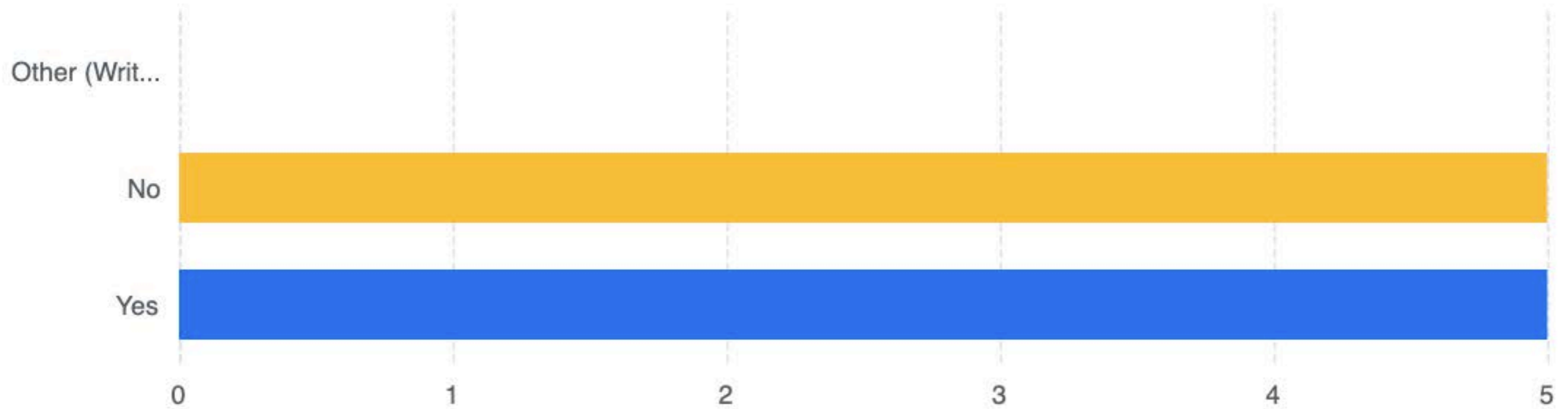

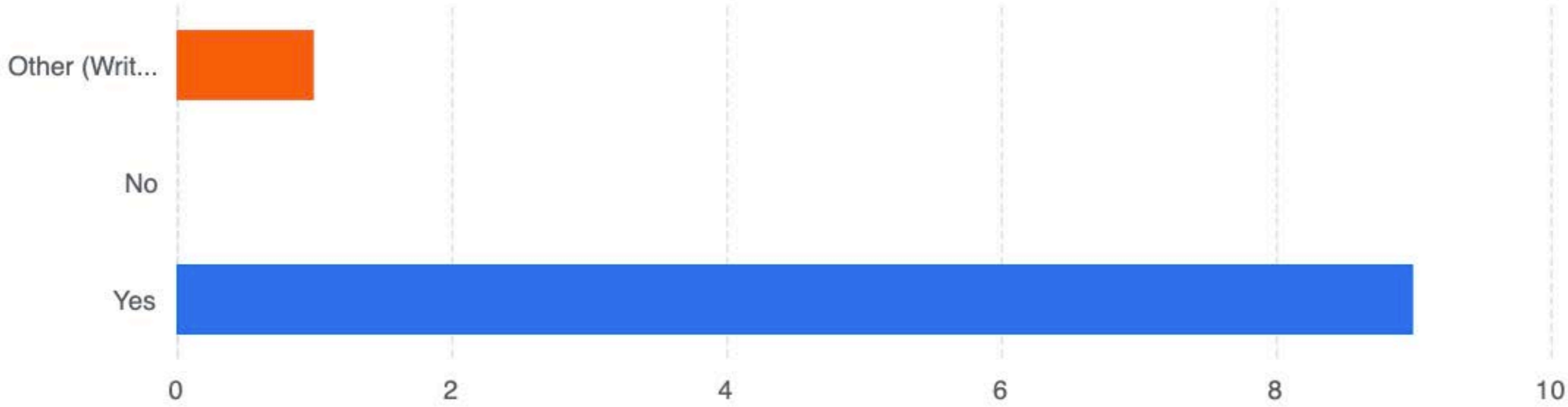

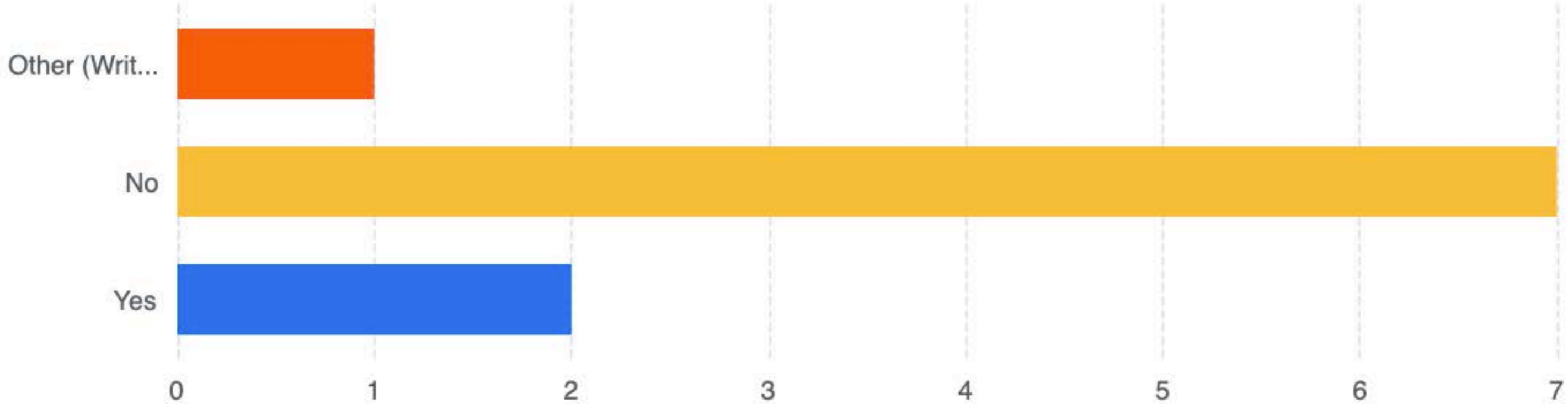

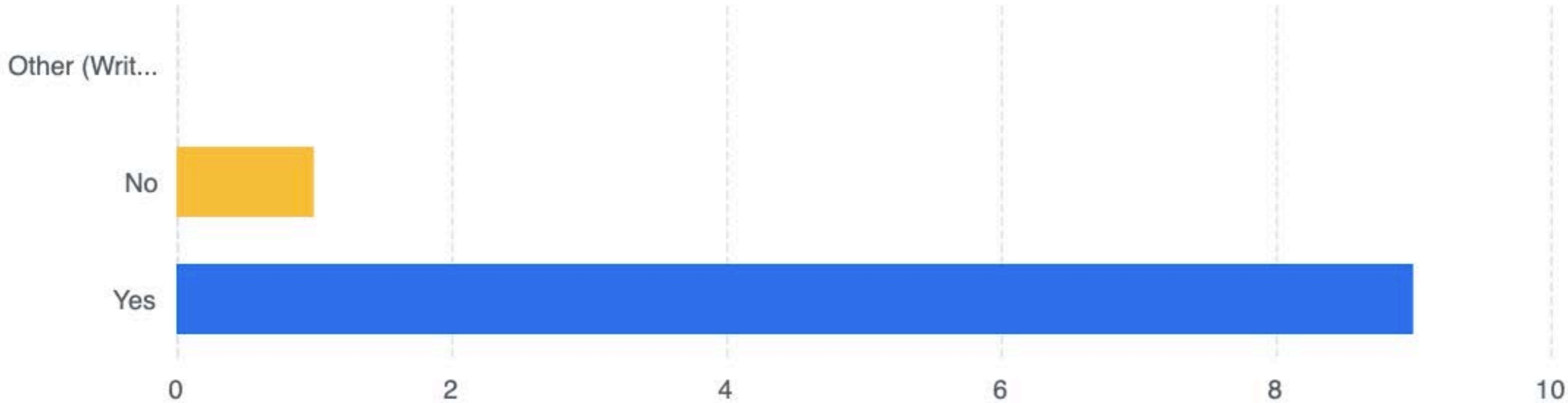
