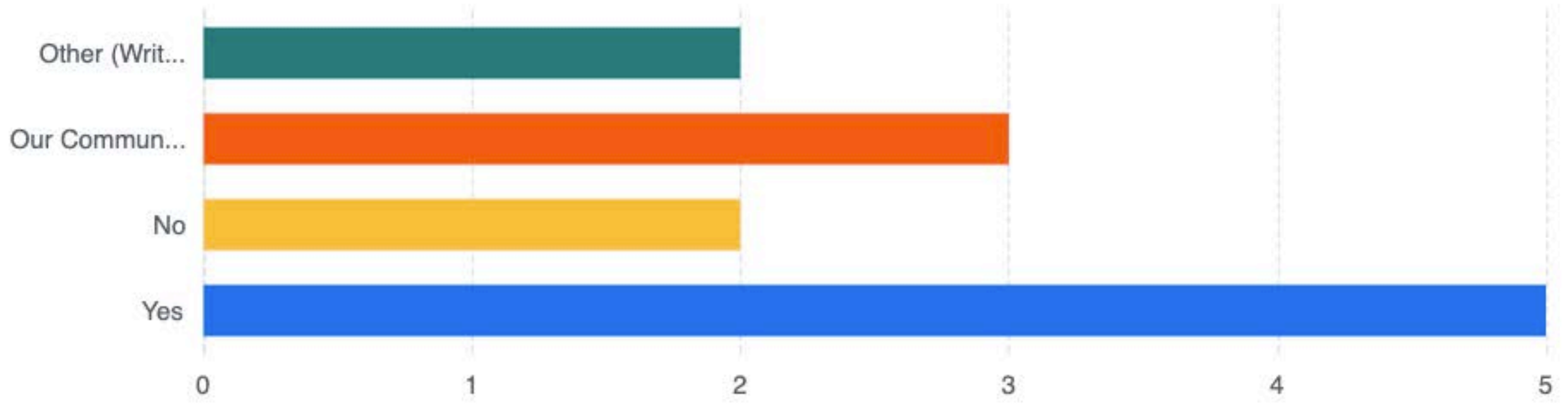


1. Is arts, culture, and placemaking built into your community's economic development strategy? (Single choice) *

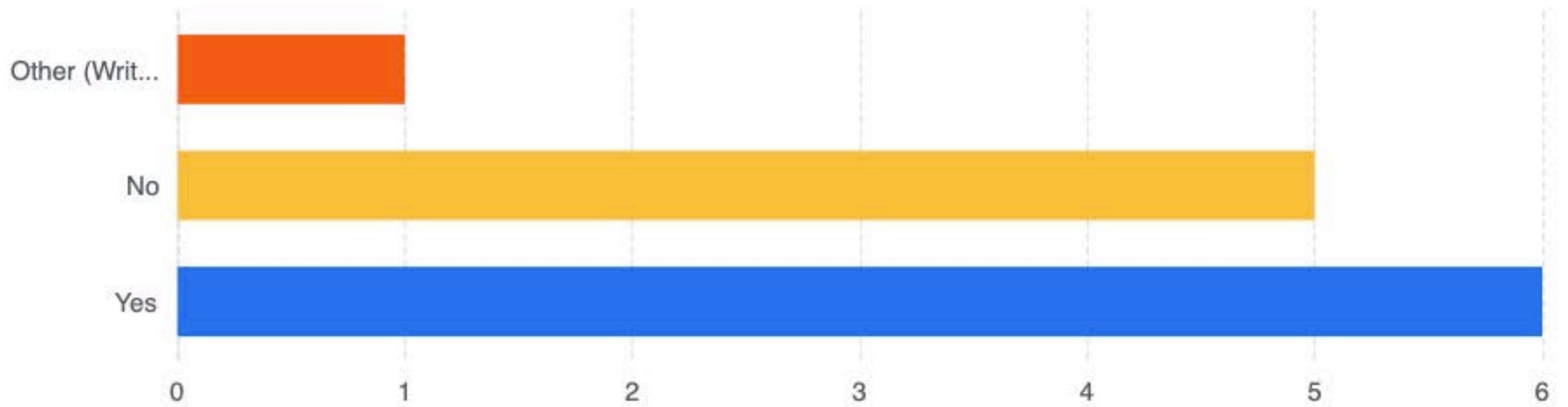

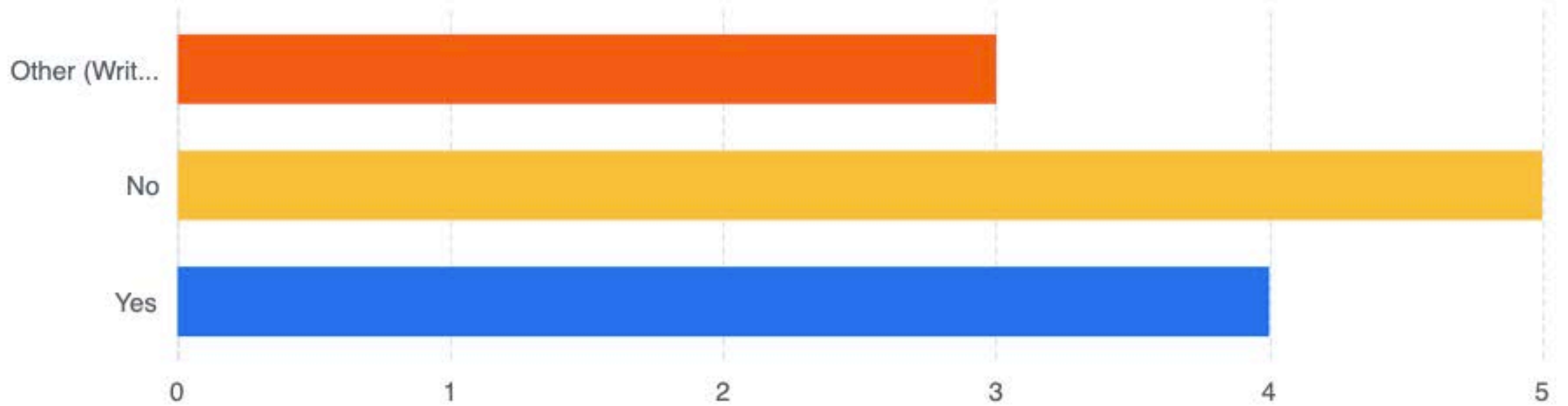

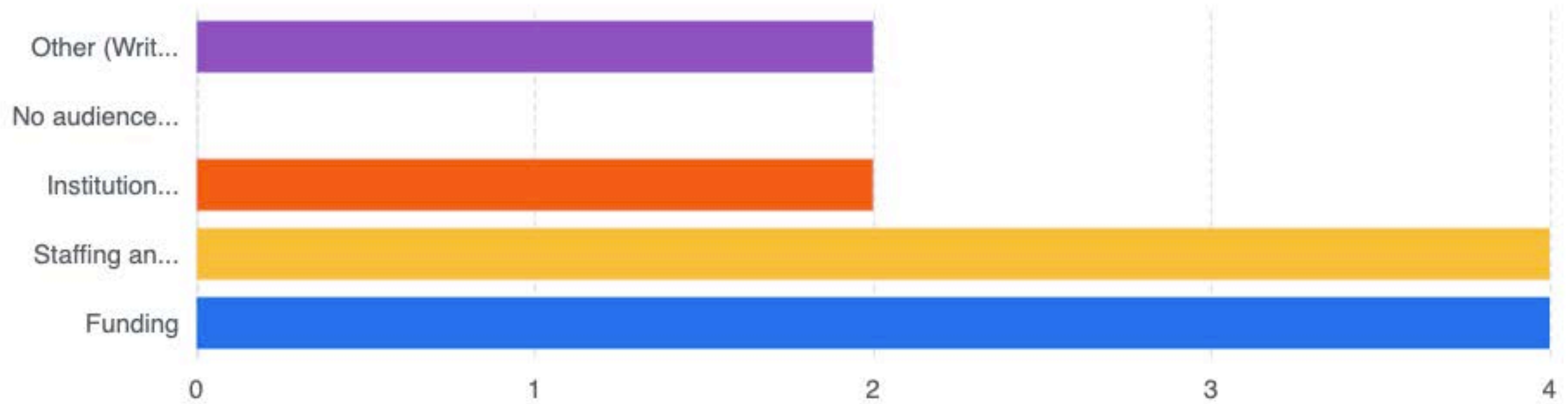

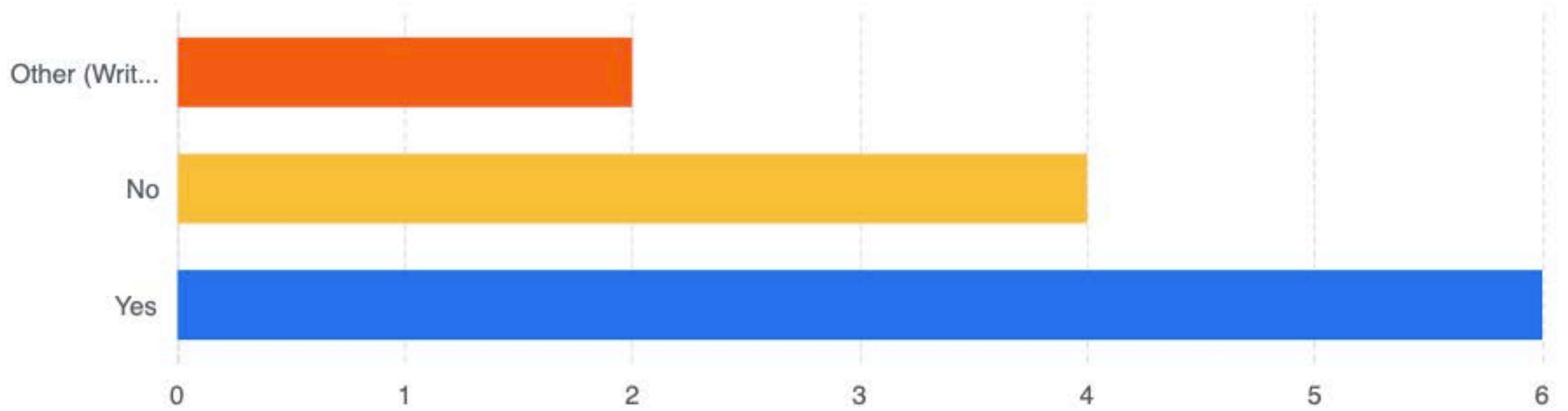

5. Does your organization have a plan for continuing arts, culture, and placemaking when your current Jobs First Catalyst funding (or current project work) ends? (Single choice) *

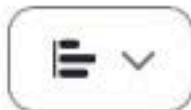

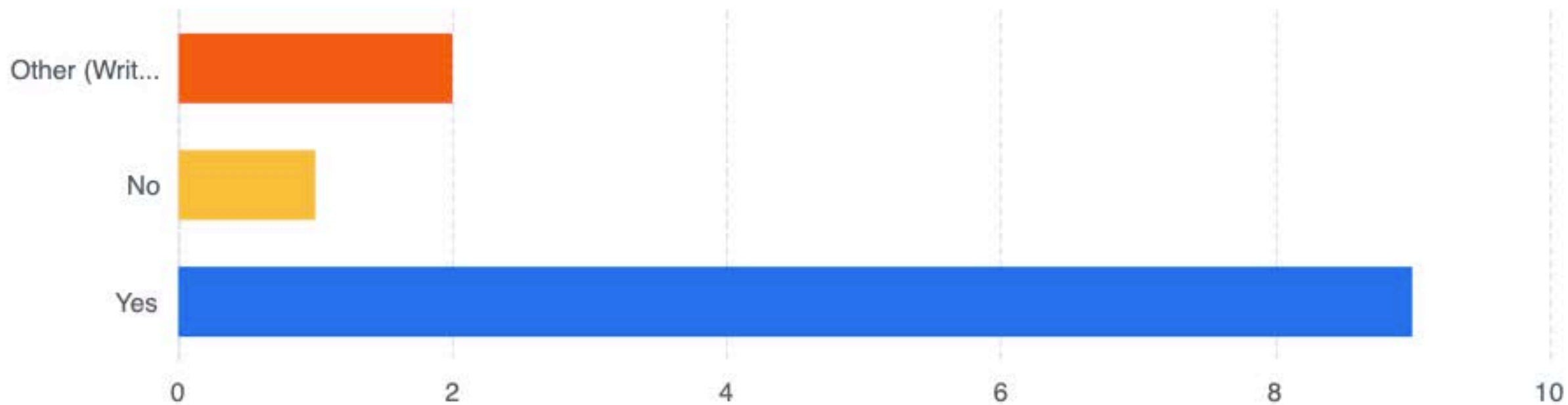
