

BUTTERMILK INFRASTRUCTURE & RECREATION PLANNING INITIATIVE (BIRPI)

The Buttermilk Infrastructure and Recreation Planning Initiative (BIRPI) will improve existing recreation infrastructure, create a focused recreation plan for the Buttermilk Bouldering Area, and develop a long-term conceptual recreation plan for the Buttermilk Project Area. The infrastructure and planning efforts will enhance the resilience of recreation amenities and natural resources in the Owens watershed.


In the Buttermilk Bouldering Area, the BIRPI will replace and/or install toilets to address the immediate needs of human sanitation. The collaborative planning effort will identify opportunities to develop a formalized system of trails, signage, kiosks, and durable soft surface parking.


In the Buttermilk Project Area, the long-term recreation planning effort will work with stakeholders to identify needs for future recreation improvements.
