



EASTERN SIERRA SCENIC BYWAY ANALYSIS

In the late 1990's, regional agencies and sponsors created the Eastern Sierra Scenic Byway, with interpretive signage along Highway 395 from Fossil Falls to Topaz Lake. Originally intended to have a lifespan of 25 years, the signs have become dated and damaged, and the accompanying brochure is no longer in distribution.

This project will review the complex jurisdictional and land tenure issues, inventory and photo document the current status of the existing signage, and identify which locations need structural improvements. The SRTI team will then present these findings, along with project options, to the ESSRP Partners to determine how best to address the future of the Eastern Sierra Scenic Byway.
