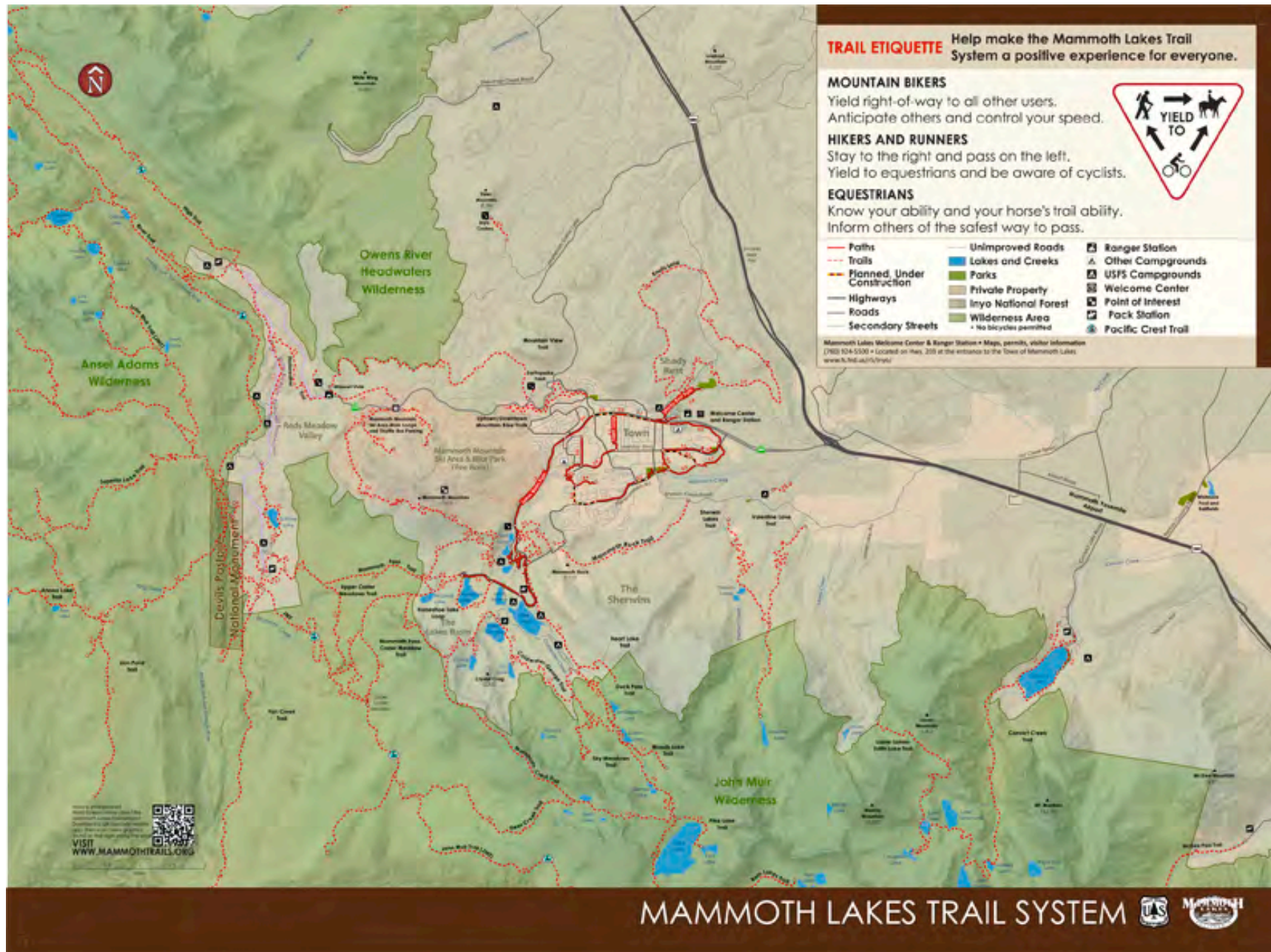

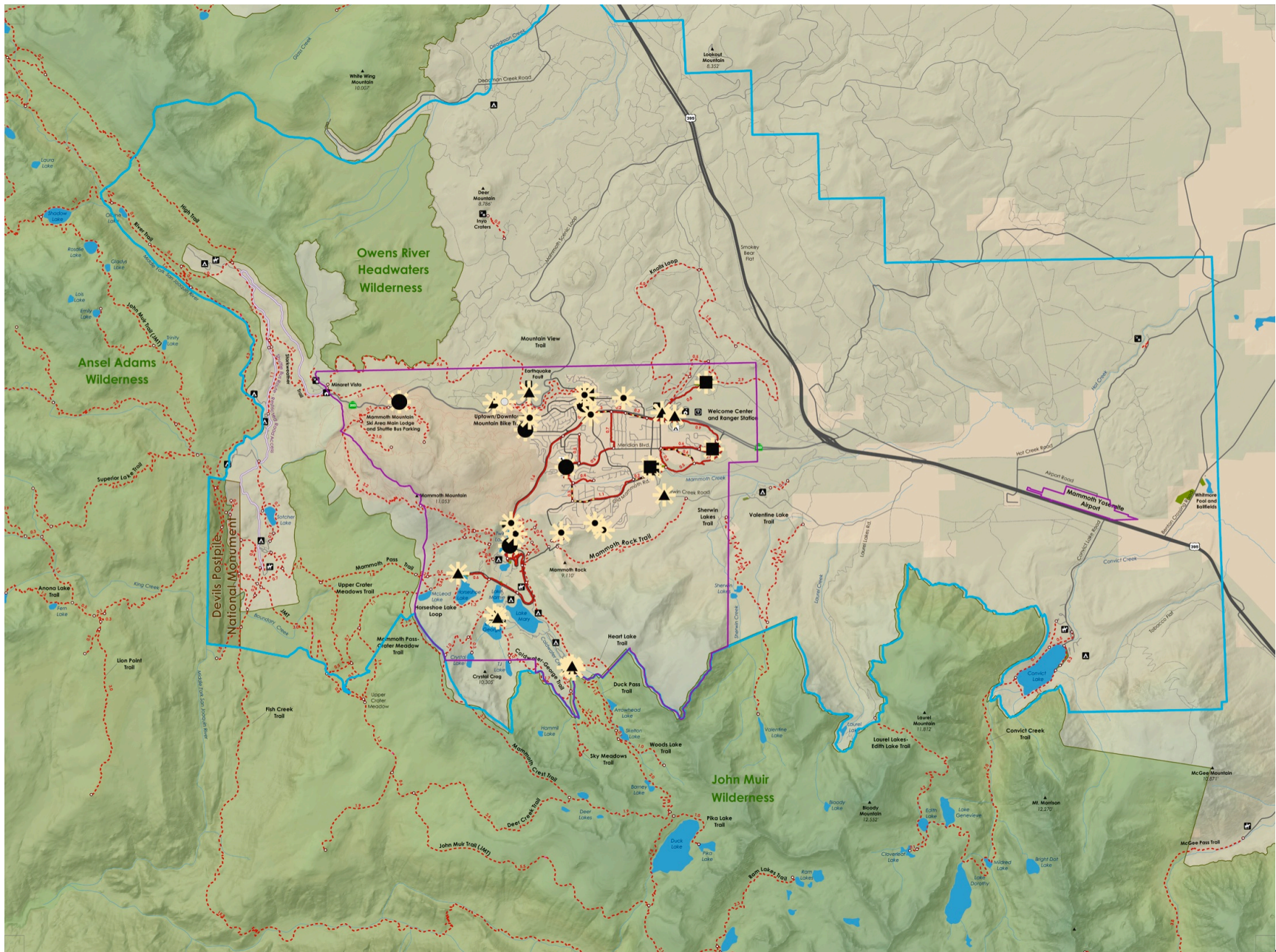


Jurisdictional Maps

MLTS Map

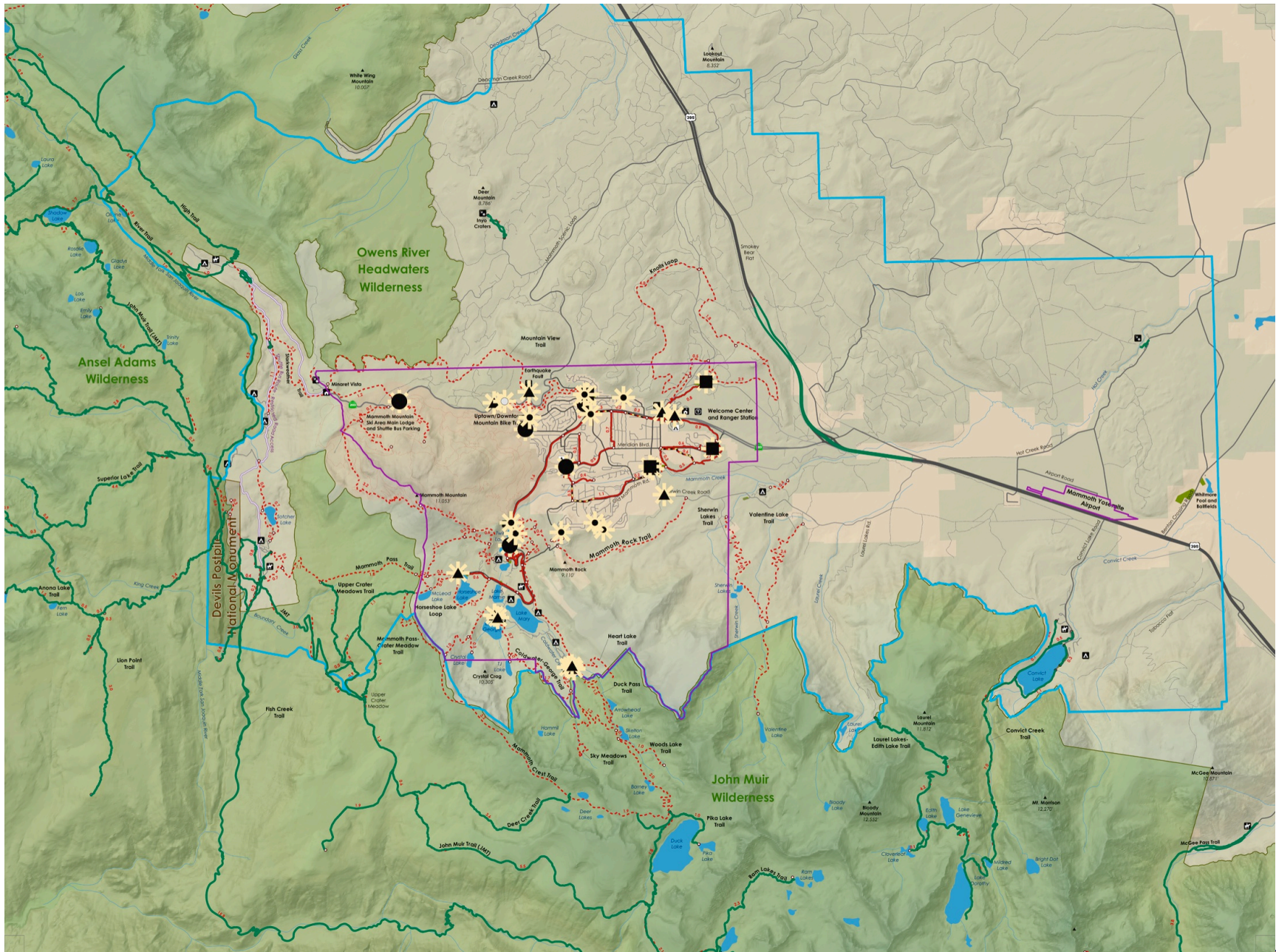


Trail System Master Plan - Nodes



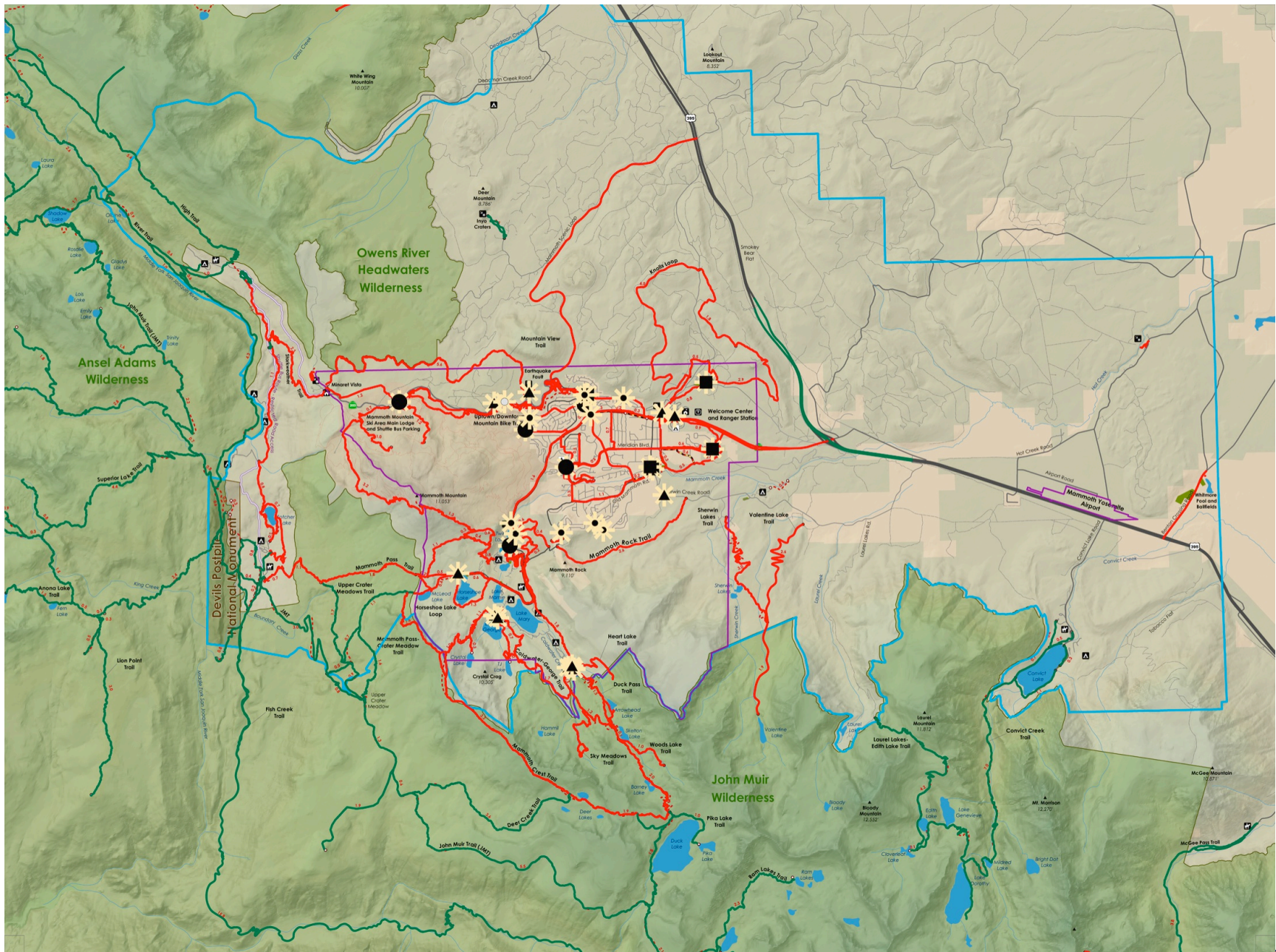

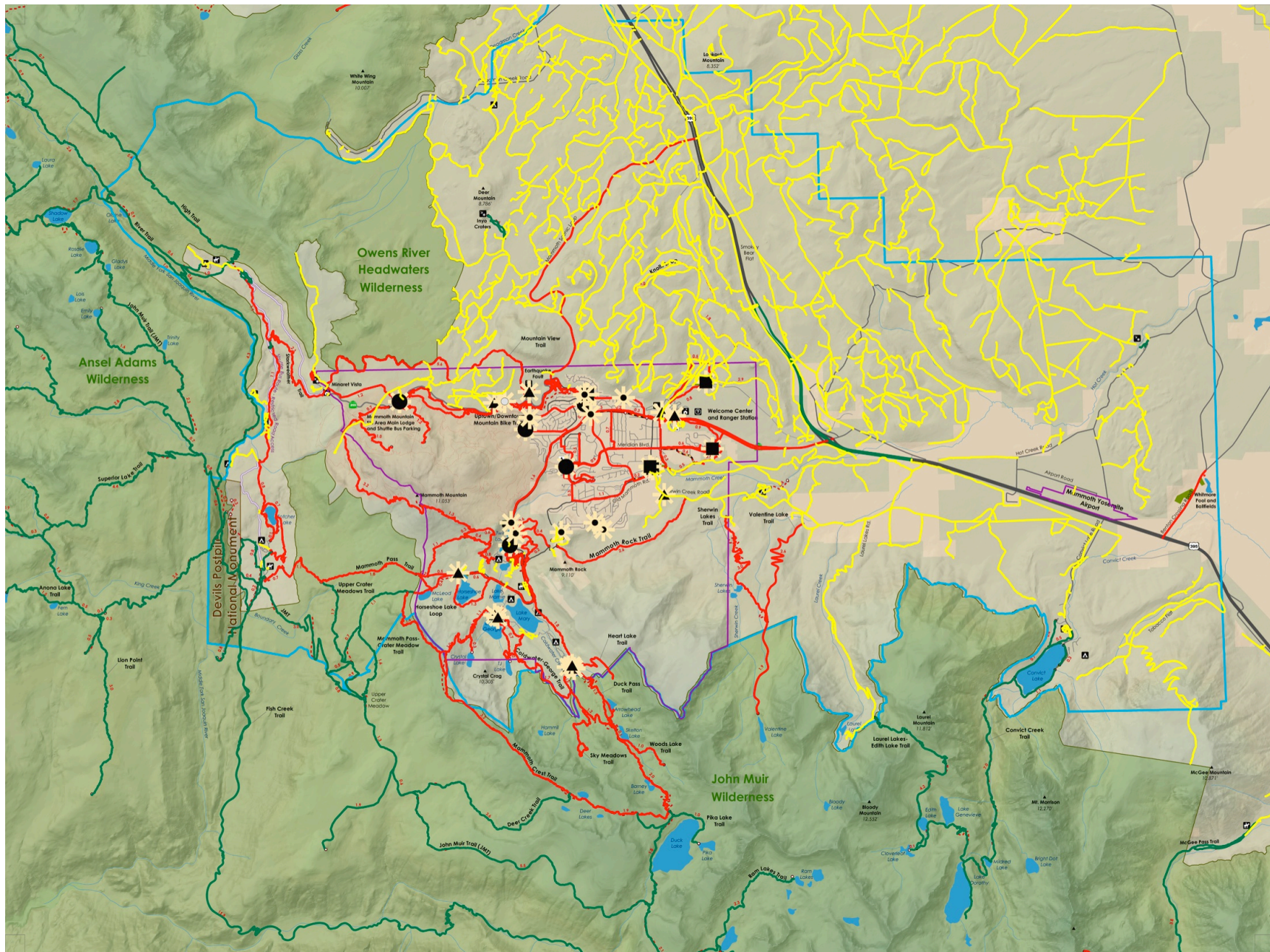

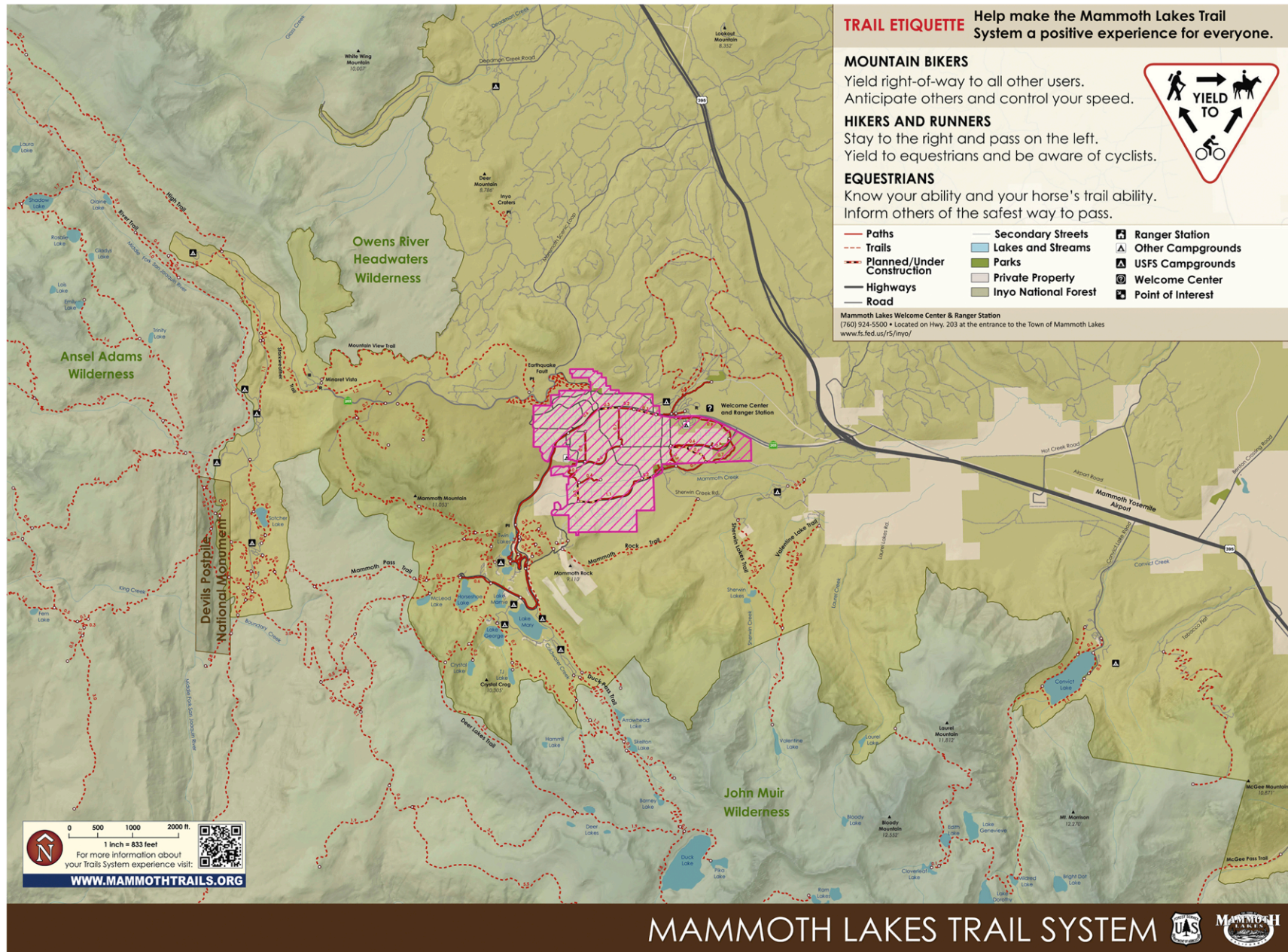

TOTAL	280 miles

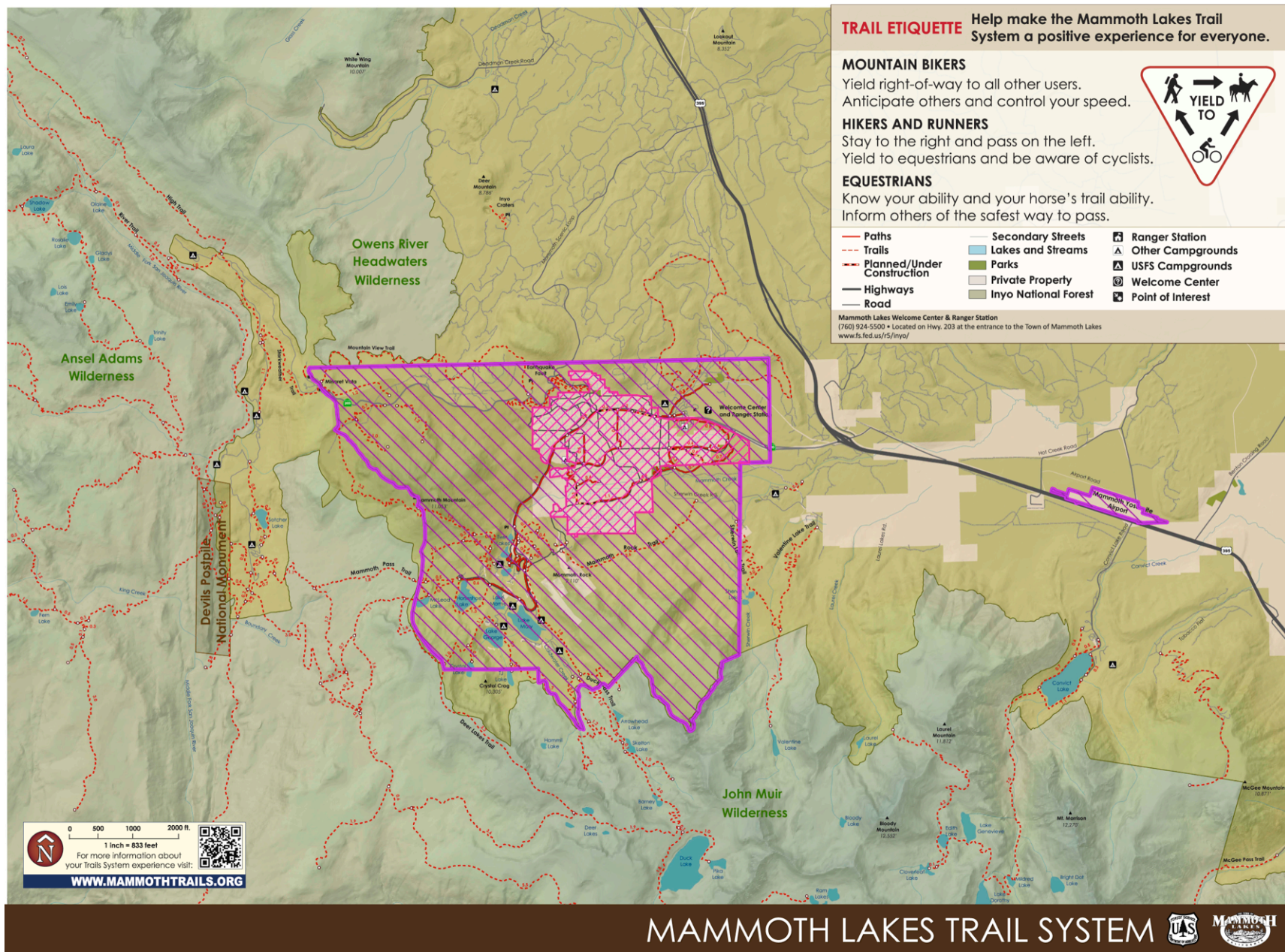

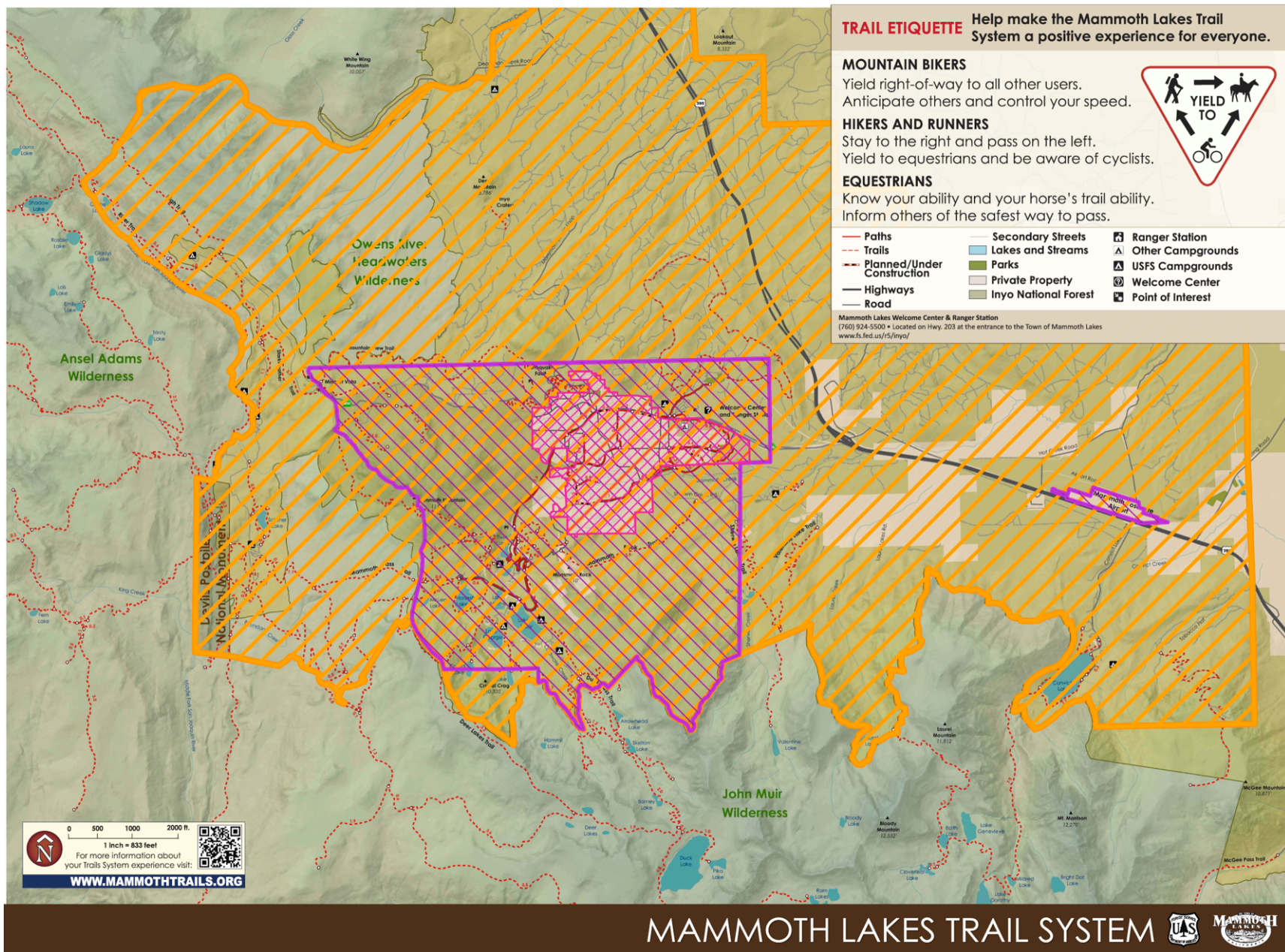
Mammoth Lakes Trail System – UGB



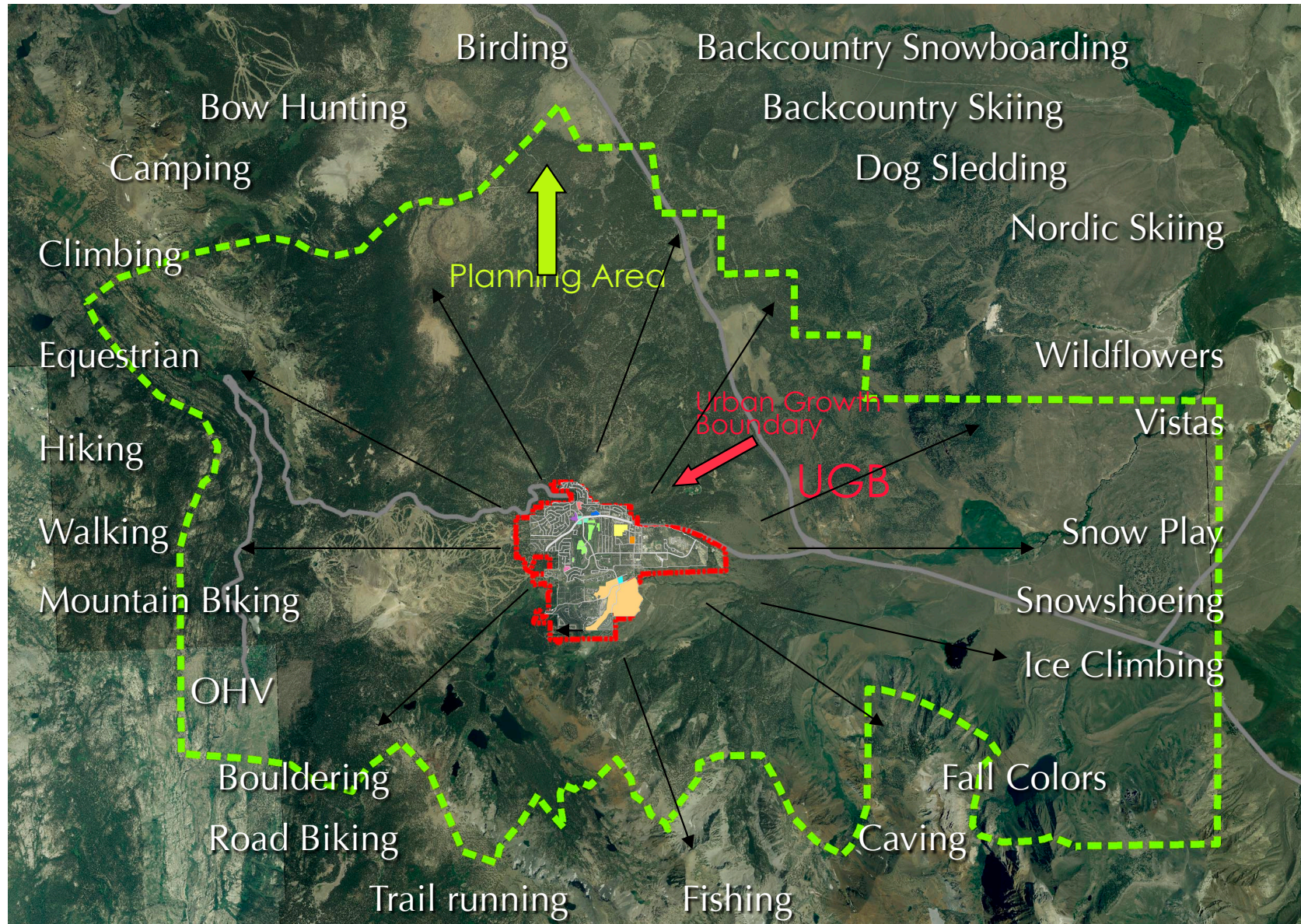
Mammoth Lakes Trail System – Municipal
